Policy Update

Policy Update – TAFE is given High Priority (Priority 1) to visa applications

- The Australian Government introduced Ministerial Direction 111 from 19 December 2024 to process offshore student visa applications with new visa prioritisation system
- High Priority (Priority 1) - High priority processing is given to visa applications for higher education providers and Vocational Education and Training providers that have not yet reached 80% of their indicative 2025 new overseas student commencements (NOSC) allocation
- High priority processing will apply to all applications from Students enrolled with a Technical and Further Education (TAFE) Provider or TAFE course with Charles Darwin University in the Northern Territory



Advanced Diploma of Marine Engineering (Class 1) - (Motor) | 1year | \$27,775

Diploma of Marine Engineering (Engineer Watchkeeper) | 1 year | \$18,725

Diploma of Maritime Operations (Watchkeeper Deck) | 1 year | \$26,650

Additional Requirement:

- Students must be assessed by the Head Teacher prior to being accepted into this course.
- Certificates of Competency in Deck or Engineer Officers courses can only be achieved via a definite pathway. Certificates are issued by the Australian Maritime Safety Authority (AMSA) as per requirements laid down in Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers (STCW), a convention of the International Maritime Organisation (IMO).
- These courses are only part of the prerequisites for AMSA. It is an AMSA requirement to have the specific and necessary training and sea service prior to final oral assessment and the issuing of the Certificates of Competency. Students need to apply for Qualifying Sea Service (QSS) approval from AMSA once they receive a letter of offer from TAFE NSW.
- AMSA requirements and their contact details are obtainable from the AMSA website.

How to check if a course is Full or Not

Choose the course and when you click on the year e.g. 2025 under “**Starting dates, course fees and locations**”, it will list the campuses, and you can see if the course is full at a location. This is updated real time as it is directly linked to the payment and issuance of CoE. There could be a time lag between payment and the system to be updated for it to reflect on the web site. There are vacancies for the upcoming July 2025 intake except for the direct entry Bachelor of Early Childhood Education and Care course.


